7. HOW WE SHARE THE INFORMATION WE COLLECT AND RECEIVE

- 7.1. We may share information with:
 - 7.1.1. a limited number of our employees and third-party service providers (other than those who we refer you to), to assist you in some way;
 - 7.1.2. our business partners. We may share non-personally identifiable information with selected business partners;

- 7.4.1.7. to any person if we are under a duty to disclose or share your personal information to comply with any Applicable Laws, or to protect the rights, property or safety of CROWN FOOD GROUP, other clients or other third parties; and/or

- 7.5.
